


Traffic Light Coding

We are going to use the colours of a traffic light as a simple way to self-assess and communicate our understanding during math this year. Remember, just as a traffic light changes, so can your understanding. Just because you are a red (or a green) for a concept one day, doesn't mean that you are always going to be that colour! Being honest with your self in your assessments is important, because knowing where you are is essential in figuring out what steps you need to take next!

	<p>RED means "I'm stuck! I don't understand this concept and I'm not sure how to move forward on my own. I need some help!"</p>
	<p>YELLOW means "I understand most of this concept but I still find some things confusing. I might need some more explanation or practice before I am ready to move on. "</p>
	<p>GREEN means "I've got this concept! I understand it and I know how to use it. I could explain it to somebody else. I am ready to move on!"</p>
